REGISTRATION

The Registration Fee is a one-time payment charged to every new student at MIS

RETURNING FEE

- A Returning Fee is charged to a returning student at MIS at the beginning of each academic year.
- (*) Pre School B refers to students who in the previous academic year were studying at Pre School A.

ANNUAL BOOK FEE

The school lends books and other materials to the students for usage. They are the property of the school and should be treated with care. Notwithstanding, there is wear and tear of materials and losses which need to be covered – thus an Annual Book Fee is charged to each student at the beginning of each academic year. Pre-school students are exempted from paying the Annual Book Fee.

DROPOUTS/ABSENTEES

The Parent/Guardian is responsible for the full payment of the fees and other school charges of the last term in which the students is registered and the last month of any extra-curricular activities. Under no circumstances will there be any discounts for absences from school or for absences from any extra services contracted

UNIFORM

Uniforms are compulsory for all students enrolled at MIS. These can be purchased at school. Information on prices are available in the school office. For more information please contact the school office.

SCHOOL FEE PAYMENT POLICY

1. Discounts

a. **Annual Payment:** Parents who pay the full year's tuition in advance receive a 5% discount.

b. Sibling Discounts:

- i.3 children: 30% discount for the youngest child.
- ii.4 children: 30% discount for the youngest and 20% for the second youngest.
- iii.5 children: 30% for the youngest, 20% for the second youngest, and 10% for the third youngest.

2. New Enrollments

- a. For new students, payment must be made in full at the time of registration, including:
 - i.Term fee
 - ii.Registration fee
 - iii.Book fee

3. Payment Deadlines per Term

- a.1st Term: by 10th of January
- b.2nd Term: by 10th of May
- c.3rd Term: by 10th of September

ACCEPTED METHODS OF PAYMENT

1. Accepted Methods of Payment

a. Cheque

- i. Payments by cheque must be made directly at the School Treasury.
- ii. A receipt will be issued immediately upon payment.

b. Direct Deposit

- i.Deposits must be made into the School's official bank account.
- ii. The original deposit slip must be presented to the School Treasury as proof of payment.
- iii. Upon verification, a receipt will be issued.

c. Bank Transfer

- i. Proof of transaction (Debit Slip) must be presented to the School Treasury.
- ii. The Treasury will obtain the corresponding Credit Slip from the bank.
- iii. A receipt will be issued only after confirmation of credit in the School's account.

2. Payment References

- a. For all Direct Deposits and Bank Transfers, the payment reference must clearly state:
 - i. The student's full name; and/or
 - ii. The corresponding invoice number in school trips

ACCEPTED METHODS OF PAYMENT

1. Restrictions

- a. Cash payments are strictly not permitted.
- b.The School reserves the right to withhold report cards, certificates, transcripts, and any other official documents or information until all outstanding fees are fully settled.

2. Penalties for Late or Non-Payment

- a. Payment delayed up to two (2) weeks
 - i.A penalty of 25% of the outstanding amount will apply.
- b. Payment delayed up to thirty (30) days
 - i.A penalty of 50% of the outstanding amount will apply
- c. Payment delayed beyond thirty (30) days
 - i. The student will not receive grades for completed assessments.
 - ii. The student will be barred from sitting for new tests.
 - iii. The student may be suspended from classes.
- d. Payment delayed beyond ninety (90) days
 - i.The student will be prohibited from participating in school trips and examinations.
 - ii.Enrollment may be canceled.

3. Enrollment and Withdrawal

- a. Students wishing to withdraw from the School must submit a written request at least two (2) months in advance.
- b.Failure to submit a formal withdrawal request will result in the student being charged new registration fees should they wish to re-enroll at the School.

4. Non-Refundable Fees

- a. The following payments are strictly non-refundable:
 - i.Registration fee
 - ii. School fee
 - iii.Returning fee
 - iv.Payments made for school trips
 - v.Book fee
