- 3. Break Work Into Small Tasks: Help them divide revision into manageable chunks to avoid feeling overwhelmed.
- 4. Practice Past Papers: Support them in using past questions to build confidence and understand exam style.
- 5. Promote Healthy Habits: Ensure they get enough sleep, eat well, and take short breaks to stay focused and energised.
